address pesticide drift connecting their efforts to communitarian and libertarian conceptions of justice the approach taken by pesticide drift activists she finds not only critiques theories of justice undergirding mainstream sustainable agriculture activism but also offers an entirely new notion of what justice means to solve seemingly intractable environmental problems such as pesticide drift harrison argues we need a different kind of environmental justice she proposes the precautionary principle as a framework for effectively and justly addressing environmental inequities in the everyday work of environmental regulatory institutions
